**REQUEST**

***The number of incidents relating to Airbnb from 01/01/2014 to 31/12/2014; 01/01/2015 to 31/12/2015; 01/01/2016 to 31/12/2016.***

***Where the incidents have been recorded as crimes, could the figures be broken down into the following categories -***

***Violent crime  
Theft offences  
Robbery  
Criminal damage and arson  
Fraud  
Hate crimes  
Anti-social behaviour***

***Also for each incident please provide: the date, a summary of the incident and the outcome of any investigation - ie. No suspect(s) identified; if suspect(s) arrested whether they were charged; cautioned; or no further action was taken.***

**RESPONSE**

I contacted our Crime Management System (CMS) Administrator for assistance with your request. This system is used to record crimes and the Outcomes that the Home Office specifies should be recorded as 'crimes'.

She advised:

*"I have searched CMS circumstances of offence free text field for the term 'Airbnb' and this has returned a nil"*

I also contacted our Incident Management System Administrator to assist with the incident element of your request. The Force 'Incident Management System' records incidents and calls to the force in accordance with the National Standard for Incident Recording (NSIR) and the National Incident Category List (NICL).

He advised:

*"Having searched the archive database for the phrases '% AIRBNB %' and '% AIRBNB%' - no incidents were returned"*
