REQUEST

On how many occasions have drivers caught by fixed or mobile speed cameras in 2020 in South Yorkshire, how many fines have been issued, and how much has been paid in fines.

Please provide this information broken down by location of the speed camera.

RESPONSE

In order to assist me with your request, I contacted our Safety Cameras and Ticket Processing Department. Their Analyst has provided the attached document outlining the number of Fixed Penalties by location. He has provided the following:-

The total number of offences dealt with by way of Fixed Penalty in 2020 was 12151.

Revenue generation is not the concern of this organisation. The revenue from fines has always been payable through the Courts system to HM Treasury.

The police only receive costs to enforce the speed limit. Fines from Conditional Offers are paid direct to HM Treasury and some offences are dealt with at Court where a fine may be imposed. This again is paid directly to HM Treasury.
