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Role purpose:	<p>Enhance public safety on the roads.</p> <p>Undertake Intelligence-lead Tasking and maintain high-visibility policing.</p> <p>Help to provide an environment where individuals can use the roads within South Yorkshire with confidence, and prevent and detect road-user-related criminal activity.</p>
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Summary of Main Duties:

Prepare for and participate in Policing Operations.

Provide an initial response to road policing incidents, including conducting an initial investigation and managing and preserving the scene.

Carry out initial investigations which will include interviewing suspects, victims and witnesses. This could include providing care for victims and witnesses or first aid.

Conduct arrest and process procedures and complete prosecution procedures.

Conduct searches of persons or personal property, which could include vehicles, premises and land
Be involved in the monitoring and maintenance of road safety and the prevention of injuries on our roads. This would include conducting roadside vehicle inspections.

Adopt a problem solving approach to Road Policing issues.

Provide specialist advice and knowledge on Road Policing.

Provide a community response, recognising the needs of all our communities and provide a victim-lead service to all.

Work as part of a team and undertake other duties relevant to the role.

Support and update social media (engagement; therefore potentially identified).

Prepared to support Districts and Departments as required.

Periodically pass a police Advanced Driving Course, gaining authority to drive vehicles in fleet classification Group A.

Attain and maintain a Tactical Pursuit and Containment (TPAC) course qualification.

Attend training and undertake duties of Family Liaison Officer.

Promote equality, diversity and Human Rights in working practices and maintain standards of professional practice.
